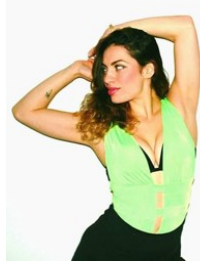


Upcoming Events at Legacy

FIRE SAFETY

On Wednesday, April 26th at 2:15pm we will be conducting our annual 'Resident Fire Drill.'

During this drill, you will be instructed to stay in your suites and place your red fire tag on the outside of your door to alert that you are safe. Please note this drill is not an evacuation. You can find a copy of instructions enclosed in this newsletter.

The doors to your suite have an 8 hour burn time so the safest place to be in the event of a fire is in your suite.

Our staff will be surveying the floors and making note of who is and who isn't in their suites.
